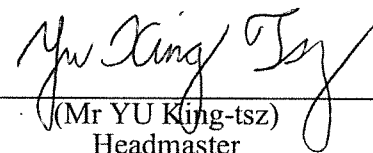

1. Through learning a Chinese dance on the theme of kites, incorporating elements of Chinese culture, enable students to appreciate the historical and cultural value of kites as a traditional Chinese folk art, deepen their understanding of the fine traditional Chinese culture, cultivate affection for their country, strengthen their sense of national identity, and take on the responsibility of carrying forward Chinese culture.
2. Through Chinese dance training and collective rehearsals, enable students to take part in stage performances, experience the importance of formation changes, movement coordination and group dance cooperation, and further enhance their collaborative skills, sense of discipline, concentration, team spirit and self-confidence, demonstrating a positive and upward-looking spirit.
3. Through participation in the "Heart Linked to the Nation" inter-school national education performance for the 30th anniversary of Hong Kong's reunification, showcase the unique charm and contemporary vitality of Chinese culture through kite dance, promote exchange and interaction among teachers and students of different schools, and jointly advance the sustainable development of national education and Chinese cultural education in primary schools.

Course Content

Through performing pieces imbued with elements of Chinese culture, deepen students' understanding and appreciation of the history and culture of the Chinese nation, cultivate affection for their country, strengthen their sense of national identity, and take on the responsibility of carrying forward the fine traditional Chinese culture.
2. Through ensemble training, enable students to take part in stage performances, experience the coordination and different functional roles of the various sections, and further enhance their collaborative skills, organisational abilities, sense of discipline, team spirit and self-efficacy.
3. Through participation in the "Heart Linked to the Nation" inter-school national education performance for the 30th anniversary of Hong Kong's reunification, promote exchange and interaction among teachers and students of different schools, and jointly advance the sustainable development of national education in primary schools.

Activity Period

Course Content

Learn about the history and playing techniques of the ancient instruments - the Xun (ocarina) and the Xiao Ruan (small plucked lute) - and learn to play pieces for these instruments.

Instrument Learning

"Heritage of Ancient Tones - Xun" & "Heritage of Ancient Tones - Xiao Ruan" (17 sessions on Thursdays)

Dates:	15, 22, 29 October ; 26 November ; 3, 10, 17 December ; 7, 14, 21, 28 January ; 18 February ; 18 March ; 8, 15, 22 April ; 6 May
Time:	4:00 pm - 5:00 pm (1 hour per session)
Venue:	North Point Government Primary School
Number of participants:	6(Xun) & 12(Xiao Ruan) (in total)
Remarks:	1. Students must attend all practices, rehearsals and the performance. 2. If a student is unable to attend a practice due to illness or other commitments, the parent must inform the Xun instructor or the Xiao Ruan instructor in writing. 3. Parents are responsible for making the travel arrangements for the students to go to the activity venue. 4. Students must arrive at the activity venue on time for practices. 5. The Xun is a wind instrument and must be purchased by students, at a price of approximately HK\$200. 6. The organiser will provide Xiao Ruans for students to practise with. Students should keep the instruments in good condition and use them with care. The instruments must be returned after the performance. If an instrument is damaged, the student will be responsible for the repair costs. 7. Students are required to bring their Xun and Xiao Ruan to the activity venue for lessons.

"Xiao Ruan" (small plucked lute)	1. Have a foundation in music and the ability to read numbered notation is preferred. 2. Have experience in learning to play any Chinese or Western plucked string instrument. 3. Submit a video of approximately one minute of instrumental performance at the time of application.
