School-based After School Care Service Scheme under the Community Care Fund 2026-2027

Dear Parent / Guardian,

With funding support from the Community Care Fund, our school will continue to implement the "On-site After-school Care Services Scheme" in the 2026/27 School Year, jointly organized by the Education Bureau and the Social Welfare Department.

Please note that our partnership with the previous operating organization (New Home Association Kowloon West Service Centre) has concluded. Starting from the 2026/27 School Year, our school will partner with **Baptist Oi Kwan Social Service (BOKSS) Cheung Sha Wan Afterschool Care Service** to co-organize the scheme. BOKSS staff will be deployed to the school to provide after-school care services, allowing students to remain on campus for homework guidance, revision, social, and developmental activities.

The details of the Scheme are as follows:

Scheme Name:	School-based After School Care Service Scheme under the Community Care Fund
Dates:	Late September 2026 to August 31, 2027
Time and Venues:	Monday to Friday after school • 3:30 PM – 6:30 PM: School Classrooms
Quota:	60 students
Target:	Primary 1 to Primary 6 students
Eligibility Criteria:	Applicants must meet all of the following requirements: Child Care Need: Parents/guardians are unable to care for the student after school due to work, job seeking, retraining/internship programs, or other valid reasons. Financial Need: The student's family must be a receipt of the following: - Comprehensive Social Security Assistance (CSSA); OR - Full allowance under the Working Family Allowance (WFA) Scheme; OR - Full fee remission under Student Financial Assistance Schemes (Textbook, Travel, or Internet Access allowances); OR - Low-income families not receiving the above three government subsidies,

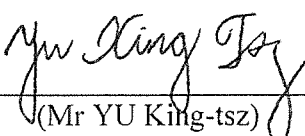
	whose monthly household income does not exceed 55% of the median monthly domestic household income in Hong Kong (see Annex 1; no asset test required). Income proof is required by BOKSS. ○ <i>Note for non-eligible families:</i> Parents who have "Child Care Needs" but do not meet the income criteria may still apply if quotas remain. Upon selection via interview, a fixed standard fee of \$1,700 HKD per month will be charged. 3. Assessment: All applicants must pass an interview and eligibility verification conducted by BOKSS.
Additional Notes:	• Weekend / Holiday Care: A quota of 12 places is available on Saturdays, Sundays, or school holidays. Care takes place at the BOKSS Centre for at least 6 hours. Details will be announced later. (Address: 1/F, 1 Fortune Street, Cheung Sha Wan, Kowloon) • Absence: If a student cannot attend a specific session, parents must inform BOKSS one day in advance and notify the school in writing.

Required Documents:	1. Student's Hong Kong ID Card / Birth Certificate; 2. Parents' / Guardian's Identity Document; 3. Valid proof of student with Special Educational Needs (SEN) (if applicable); 4. Family Income Proof: • Valid proof of receiving Comprehensive Social Security Assistance (CSSA) (if applicable); OR • Proof of receiving full allowance under the Working Family Allowance Scheme within 6 months prior to application submission (if applicable); OR • Proof of receiving full fee-waiver under Student Financial Assistance schemes (School Textbook Assistance / Student Travel Subsidy / Subsidy Scheme for Internet Access Charges) for the previous or current school year (if applicable); OR • Low-income families applying via income criteria must submit relevant household income proof (salary documents of cohabiting core family

	members in Hong Kong for the 1 or 3 months prior to application).
Late September 2026	Application results announced to families
Remark:	• If eligible applicants exceed the allocated quota, the approved service operator will maintain a waiting list to fill vacancies as students withdraw. • Families unable to attend in person on the Application Day will have an interview arranged separately by the service operator.
