Shenzhen-Hong Kong Youth Flag Raising Parade

Dear Parent/ Guardian,

Your child / ward has already completed the Summer Training Programme in September, he/she is invited to attend the graduation ceremony in Shenzhen, China. The event aims to review their learning achievements and celebrate the 75th anniversary of the founding of the People's Republic of China. Activities include foot drill training, marching parades, flag-raising ceremonies, visits and exchanges, military experiences, etc. About 1,000 students from Hong Kong and Shenzhen will participate in the event. Details are as follows:

Remarks

1. Parents are to help their child/ward to apply for the required travel documents accordingly.
 - A. Students with Chinese nationality require the following documents:
 - i. Students aged 11 or above
Hong Kong Juvenile Identity Card (with photo) + Mainland Travel Permit for Hong Kong and Macau Residents (回鄉證)
 - ii. Students under the age of 11 (either a or b)
 - a. Hong Kong Juvenile Identity Card (without photo) + Mainland Travel Permit for Hong Kong and Macau Residents (回鄉證) + Hong Kong SAR Passport (at least six months before expiration)
 - b. Re-entry Permit + Mainland Travel Permit for Hong Kong and Macau Residents (回鄉證)
 - B. Non-Chinese Permanent Residents required the following documents (either i, ii or iii)
 - i. Students age of or above
Hong Kong Juvenile Identity Card (with photo) + Mainland Travel Permit for Hong Kong and Macao Permanent Residents (Non-Chinese Citizens)(港澳居民來往內地通行證(非中國籍)); or
 - ii. Students under age of 11
Hong Kong Juvenile Identity Card (without photo) + Mainland Travel Permit for Hong Kong and Macao Permanent Residents (Non-Chinese Citizens)(港澳居民來往內地通行證(非中國籍)) + Certificate of Birth
 - iii. A valid passport (at least six months before expiration) + China Visa
(The fee for applying China Visa ranges from HK\$0-HK\$1100, depending on the student's nationality. For students who successfully apply for a China visa to Shenzhen from 19 October 2024 to 20 October 2024, the Education Bureau will subsidize the relevant fee for the visa (regular single entry only). Please submit a copy of the Visa and the receipt to the teacher in charge after you get the visa. After completing the tour and the verification procedures, the fee will be forwarded to the parents.)
 - C. Students without Chinese nationality require the following documents:
A valid passport (at least six months before expiration) + China Visa
(The fee for applying China Visa ranges from HK\$0-HK\$1100, depending on the student's nationality. For students who successfully apply for a China visa to Shenzhen from 19 October 2024 to 20 October 2024, the Education Bureau will subsidize the relevant fee for the visa (regular single entry only). Please submit a copy of the Visa and the receipt to the teacher in charge after you get the visa. After completing the tour and the verification procedures, the fee will be forwarded to the parents.)
2. Both vegetarian and non-vegetarian meals will be offered for students to choose from.
3. Students will be accompanied by teachers throughout the trip. All activities will be conducted in Putonghua.
4. The service provider will purchase insurance for the participants. Parents can also purchase extra insurance for their child/ward at their discretion.
5. **The visa fee will not be refunded if the student withdraws from the tour.**
6. The Education Bureau/organizer may take photos and videos during the tour. The relevant photos and video clips may also be displayed on the relevant website of the Education Bureau/other activities in the future and forwarded to other government departments for joint display in different media/events.

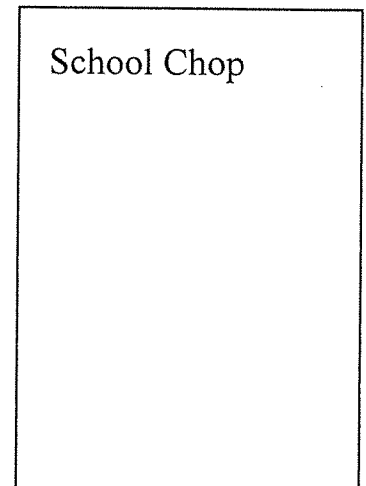
