## II. Application for Secondary One Admission

1. Each student may apply to not more than two participating secondary schools regardless of whether they are government, aided, caput or Direct Subsidy Scheme (DSS) secondary schools participating in SSPA.
2. Parents may obtain the lists in the **Handbook for Application for Secondary One Discretionary Places** in the following ways:
  - EDB’s Homepage ([www.edb.gov.hk](http://www.edb.gov.hk)): Select: Home > Education System and Policy > Primary and Secondary School Education > School Places Allocation Systems > Secondary School Places Allocation (SSPA) System
  - EDB’s 24-hour Automatic Telephone Enquiry System on [28910088](tel:28910088) (Press 2 (English) > 5 (Fax Services) > 04 (Secondary School Places Allocation System: School Lists)
  - Parents may borrow the Handbook in the School Office.
3. Parents can also choose to submit SSPA applications form via **SSPA e-platform using “iAM Smart+” app**. Parents can consult the class teacher for the procedures. The activation code has been distributed to parents on 28-11-2024 (Refer to Special Notice No.82). Please be aware that **you should NOT submit the forms twice using both paper form and e-platform**.
4. DP application is not subject to restriction on districts, your school choices are not limited to Shamhuipo district. Each student is allowed to apply to not more than two participating secondary schools (excluding Jockey Club Ti-I College) listed in the Handbook, otherwise his/her chance of acquiring a DP will be forfeited. For other points to note, please refer to the notes in Section 1 of the Handbook.

5. Apart from making DP applications to not more than two participating secondary schools, students may also apply for a S1 place at any non-participating DSS secondary school, and there is no limit to the number of non-participating DSS secondary schools they can apply to. These schools have their own schedule and administrative arrangements for admission and parents should approach the schools directly.
6. As there is no limit to the number on non-participating DSS secondary schools that a student may apply to, he/she may be accepted by several non-participating DSS secondary schools. However, provided the parent has surrendered the signed undertaking and the original of the Primary 6 Student Record Form to one of the schools making the offer, this will serve as a confirmation of the acceptance of the S1 place offered by the non-participating DSS secondary school and the agreement to give up any other subsidized S1 places (including the S1 places of participating secondary schools and Jockey Club Ti-I College).
7. DSS secondary schools may be fee-charging. S1 students admitted to DSS secondary schools may be promoted to S4 in their own schools upon completion of S3 and will not be centrally placed to S4 in other schools subvented by EDB.
8. The DP application period for the 2023/2025 allocation cycle is from 2.1.2025 (Thursday) to 16.1.2025 (Thursday), both days inclusive. Parents should take note of the operating hours of individual secondary schools to ensure timely submission of their applications.
9. Parents / Guardians are advised to study the Notes for Parents on Application for Secondary One Discretionary Places for details. Parents may refer to the **Secondary School Profiles 2024/2025** published by the Committee on Home-School Cooperation when selecting schools for their children. The Profiles provide the basic information about the schools such as school characteristics, facilities, class structures, extra-curricular activities, fees, etc. The Profiles will be given to you in due course.
10. The list of Secondary schools mainly **using English as a medium of instructions** is prepared for your reference (see Appendix I). Please be reminded that subjects such as Chinese Language and Chinese History etc. are taught in Chinese. You can browse their school websites for further details and updated information. For more choices, please refer to the Handbook.
11. Parents should make reference to the school characteristics, curriculum, class structure, facilities, extra-curricular activities, fees and admission criteria in order to select a suitable school for your children.
12. Application for admission to Secondary One (S1) of **Jockey Club Ti-I College** is from 2.1.2025 (Thursday) to 20.1.2025 (Monday), both days inclusive. Parents who are interested in applying should ask the class teachers for the application forms and related documents.
13. To help parents to complete the form properly, each student is given a draft of the application form to fill in and they should return it to the class teacher on 11.12.2024 (Wednesday). The original application form will be given to parents on 12.12.2024 (Thursday) after checking the draft by the class teachers.
14. Students should bring along the **Application Forms** when they apply for Secondary One Discretionary Places. Parents should take good care of those forms.

15. Parents should also keep the **Primary 6 Student Record Form** with care. The form is used as an identity document when students apply for S1 admission to Jockey Club Ti-I College and non-participating DSS schools.

### **III. Release of Results**

1. The Secondary School will notify parents of successful applications for Discretionary Places by letter and phone on 31.3.2025 (Monday). Parents who applied through the e-platform will be notified via the “iAM Smart+” app. (Unsuccessful applications will not receive notification).
2. Successful DP applicants will not be allocated a place again in the Central Allocation (CA). Students who have not been successful in obtaining DP will be allocated a S1 Place in Central Allocation.
3. The result of Central Allocation will be released on **8.7.2025 (Tuesday)**.

### **IV. Dates for Registration of Secondary One Students**

Registration of Secondary One students will be scheduled on **10.7.2024 (Thursday) and 11.7.2025 (Friday)**.

### **V. Application for Cross-Net Allocation (First Batch)**

Please note that application for cross-net allocation in the SSPA 2023/2025 cycle is open for students residing or home-moving in the district other than Sham Shui Po. Parents should also take note of the important points in the Appendix II.

Class teacher will distribute the application form for those in need on **10.12.2024 (Tuesday)**. Parents are requested to complete and submit the application form with a copy of residential address proof document (e.g. stamped tenancy agreement / demand note for rates and/or government rent / tenancy agreement or tenant’s rent card issued by the public housing authorities / residential telephone bill or the bills from various utility companies such as Town Gas, Hong Kong Electric Company Ltd., Water Supplies Department etc.) to their class teachers on **12.12.2024 (Thursday)**. Other documents such as bank’s statements and mobile bills will not be accepted.

**Important Notes for Cross-Net Allocation**

- (a) Parents can submit Cross-Net applications form via paper form or using the “iAM Smart+” e-platform, parents please consult the class teachers for the procedures.
- (b) To submit a Cross-Net Form via eSSPA, parents should first register as eSSPA users and bind their account to “iAM Smart+”. Parents can submit during the application periods.  
\*First Batch: 5 December 2024 to 2 January 2025
- (c) If parents have submitted a paper Cross-Net Form to their child’s attending primary school, they should not submit a duplicate application via the eSSPA, and vice versa.
- (d) For application submitted via the eSSPA, parents should upload copies of the relevant proof documents and may be required to present the original documentary proofs to the primary school for verification in accordance with the school-based needs.
- (e) The applicant should be the parent / guardian of the student in the record kept by school and lives with the student in the same residential address.
- (f) The applicant should complete the application form for cross-net allocation and submit it with copies of residential address proof documents to school as early as possible. The parents concerned are also required to present the original copy of the documentary proofs to the school for validation.
- (g) The applying student’s residential address should be his/her sole or chief residential address. Acceptable residential address proof documents include stamped tenancy agreement, demand note for rates and/or government rent, tenancy agreement or tenant’s rent card issued by the public housing authorities, residential telephone bill, and the bills from various utility companies, like Town Gas, Hong Kong Electric Company Ltd., Water Supplies Department etc. Other documents such as bank’s statements and mobile phone bills will not be accepted.
- (h) The name and address of the parent/guardian (i.e. the payee) must be printed on the residential address proof document.
- (i) After validating the application form and the residential address proof from parents, the school will enter on the form ‘Application for Cross-Net Allocation’ (to be completed by school only) that the student concerned will change to his/her home district for central allocation.
- (j) If necessary, the Bureau will contact the parents/guardians concerned direct to confirm the correctness of the supporting documents. The parents/guardians may also be required to make sworn declarations. During the verification process, if a parent/guardian cannot provide the necessary documents or refuse to make a sworn declaration, the application for cross-net



allocation will not be approved. The student can only participate in the central allocation in his/her original school net.

- (k) If a student applying for cross-net allocation has submitted application(s) to secondary school(s) for discretionary place(s), before moving home, and the parent wishes to cancel the discretionary place application(s), please indicate on the application form too. He/She is also required to inform the secondary school(s) concerned in writing of the cancellation, and copy the letter(s) to the class teacher when he/she hands in the application form.
  
- (l) During the computer procedure of Central Allocation, the school net allocation band of the student approved for cross net allocation may be different from the one in his/her original school net since his/her score will be compared with other students in the new school net.
